General Shoot Information

The Virginia Trapshooting Association (VTA) shoots will be held at the VTA Homegrounds, Winchester Gun Club, Stephenson, VA. The VTA will have full responsibility for conducting these shoots. The VTA and the Winchester Gun Club are not responsible for accidents or injuries on the Winchester Gun Club grounds.

All current ATA and VTA rules and regulations will be enforced. The VTA reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry. The VTA also reserves the right to change the program for any reason. No entry fee options will be refunded unless an event is cancelled.

On the first day of the shoot, you can only sign up in the morning for that day; sign up for the remaining shoot program can be done that afternoon.

Targets will be shot 50/50 on 6 banks, 2 traps per bank. All handicap and 16-yard targets will be shot 5 per station. However, management reserves the right to alter this scheme depending on the number of entries. The squad leader has the responsibility to keep the squad moving through the 50 targets in a timely fashion.

Squads may be reassigned different fields at the discretion of management. If you are on a late squad, do not sign up for an early squad for the next event.

The two practice traps will be the last two traps at the right end of the firing line. There is sufficient parking at that location with an access road. Cost is \$7 for 25 targets.

Shootoffs will be carried over to the next day when permitted.

All options are percentage.

If not won, 50s money will carry over to the next event. High score in the last 50s event will win.

Darkness and inclement weather

In the event of inclement weather or darkness before an event is concluded, shooting will resume at 8:00 am the following day to complete the event.

Trophies

If you win a trophy at one of the VTA shoots, pick it up or arrange to have someone pick it up for you by the end of the shoot. The VTA has no secure storage and will not be responsible for trophies left at the conclusion of the shoot. It is your responsibility to collect your winnings.

Presquadding

We are expecting a larger than normal crowd this year. Therefore, shooters are encouraged to presquad. Presquadding will be available on ScoresR.com.

Money Returned by the ATA

The amount returned to the VTA: \$3098.

Vendors

There is no rent for vendors but please contact Mike Wilder at (304) 919-1025.

Campers

The Winchester Gun Club (WGC) maintains a camping area for trailers, motor homes and tents. Water and electricity are available. Showers and restroom facilities are at the main clubhouse. Rental is \$30.00 per day for 30 amp service and \$40 per day for 50 amp service. You may request a reservation for the state shoot, however, unless paid 15 days prior to the shoot date, we will not be able to guarantee the reservation. Contact Mike Wilder by message at 304-919-1025.

Gun Club Representative Meeting

The VTA Gun Club Representative Meeting will be Friday, July 3, 2026 at 8am. This is a closed meeting, open only to the designated Gun Club Representatives.

State Association Meeting

The VTA meeting will be held on Saturday, July 4, 2026 after the conclusion of Event 9 (before shoot-offs). It is open to all current VTA members.

Classification and Handicapping

The Classification Committee will classify and handicap all shooters. Current averages will be used, plus known ability. Any shooter may shoot targets only to avoid being penalized in any event. All shooters must present their average card and ATA plastic membership card to the Classification Committee to be classified. **It is the shooter's responsibility to have his/her average card up to date.**

16 Yards – 5 Classes

97% and above	AA

If you have or tie the high score in your class, regardless of any category standing, you will be moved up one class.

Special Category Shooters

It is the responsibility of the shooter to declare him/her self as a category shooter for the tournament, if you choose to do so. Once a declaration has been made, the declaration is final and can not be changed. You must also inform the cashier when you pay for each event.

-Parent-Child (under 18)

-Sub-Junior – A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birthday

-Junior – One who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday

-Junior Gold - Over 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday

-Sub-Veteran - Over 55 but has not reached his/her 65th birthday

-Veteran – One who is 65 but has not reached his/her 70th birthday

-Senior Veteran – One who is 70 years or older

-Lady1 - a lady who has not reached her 55th birthday

-Lady2 - A lady who has reached her 55th birthday

When we say junior in non-championship events, we mean sub-junior and junior; those who would be junior gold will shoot with other undeclared shooters.

We will follow ATA rule IV, J – a shooter may declare only one category – and rule X, D, 4 – a shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her category will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. However, any special category shooter, whose scores do not qualify for a trophy in his/her special category, may compete for place, class, or yardage trophies.

Target Requirements for all VTA Shoots

16-yard Targets: A shooter must have registered at least 500 16-yard targets in the current year and at least 1,000 targets in the current and previous year combined or be placed in B class or higher.

Handicap Targets: A shooter must have registered at least 500 handicap targets in the current year and at least 1,000 targets in the current and previous year combined or be penalized 2 yards in addition to his/her normal yardage, - 21 yard minimum, 25 yard maximum. Shooters of senior veteran age will not be penalized.

Doubles Targets: A shooter must have registered at least 750 doubles targets in the current and previous year combined or be placed in “B” class or higher.

For the Old Dominion shoot only, the current year will be the 2026 and 2027 target years combined; the previous target year will be 2025.

2026 Virginia Hall of Fame Inductee

Scott Petitto

Scott began his clay target shooting journey in 1990 while attending George Mason University, where he took the trap & skeet class taught by VTHoF member and Collegiate National Championship coach John R. Linn. The sport quickly became a passion, and through dedication - practicing four to five days a week, working the scorer's chair, and spending countless hours on the line - Scott earned a spot on GMU's first team trap squad and contributed to three ACUI Collegiate National Championships.

Since registering his first ATA targets in 1991, Scott has shot more than 110,000 registered targets and built an exceptional competitive record. His major titles include the 1993 Virginia State Handicap Championship and the 2005 Virginia State Singles Championship, where he posted the event's lone perfect 200×200. He has also been State Runner up in Singles and Doubles and has accumulated more than 80 class and yardage trophies across State, Zone, Satellite Grand, and Grand American events. At the Grand American's Champion of Champions event, Scott maintains a remarkable 99/100 average.

Beyond competition, Scott has devoted almost three decades to supporting and growing trapshooting in Virginia. His service includes roles as Virginia's ATA Second Alternate Delegate, VTA Trustee, Director of the VTHOF scholarship program, longtime volunteer at Crush'n Clays, and coach or mentor to more than 50 GMU team members and AIM youth shooters. He also supported AFC IWLA registered shoots for almost 30 years in roles ranging from scorer and loader to shoot management and RSO.

Scott's career reflects excellence, commitment and a lasting dedication to the sport he loves.

Thank you to everyone who supported the Virginia Trapshooting Hall of Fame in 2025. It was a year of real growth and momentum. We received the most scholarship applications in our history, saw strong participation in the Virginia Youth Trapshooting League, launched a new trap sponsorship program for the Hall of Fame Shoot (expanding to all three VTA shoots in 2026), and our year-end fundraising campaign positioned us well for the 2026 season.

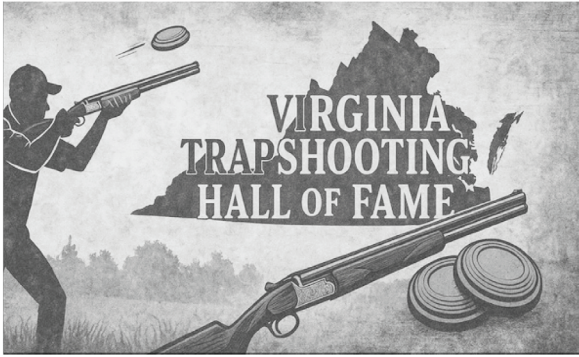
For those unfamiliar with our organization, the Virginia Trapshooting Hall of Fame, Inc. is a non-profit organization that encourages youth to participate in trapshooting.

Each year, the VTHoF performs four primary activities:

1. Provides youth shooters with reduced target fees at the Hall of Fame Shoot, which is the AIM and Virginia Youth Trapshooting League championships.
2. Awards one \$500 scholarship to a Virginia resident youth shooter annually. Information about the scholarship is on the VTHoF website and from any of the directors. The deadline for this year's application is June 15, 2026.
3. Supplies awards and trophies to the Virginia Youth Trapshooting League.
4. Oversees the annual induction of a Virginia trap shooter into the Virginia Trapshooting Hall of Fame. Nominees have superior marksmanship and/or have an exceptional record volunteering to benefit trapshooting in Virginia. Voting is conducted by the living inductees of the Hall of Fame. More information is available on the VTHoF website and from any of the officers and directors. The deadline for this year's nominations is December 31, 2026.

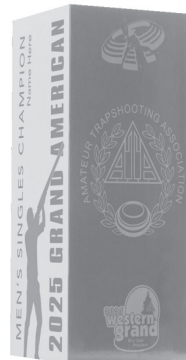
